

Introduction

The 7 Day Wildlife & Waterfalls visits Zambia's Victoria Falls, and Botswana's Chobe National Park and Okavango Delta. In Livingstone you will stay near the Victoria Falls and enjoy a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River and a guided tour of the Victoria Falls, one of the 'Seven Natural Wonders of the World'.

Only a short road transfer from Livingstone to the Chobe National Park in Botswana, Africa's undisputed elephant kingdom. In Chobe you will enjoy guided open vehicle game drives in the Chobe National Park and game viewing boat cruises on the Chobe River.

Flying in light aircraft from Chobe to the Okavango Delta, this is a very scenic flight with great opportunities of spotting wildlife. The Okavango Delta is a natural wonder and World Heritage Site. You will stay at a luxury tented camp located in a remote corner of the Okavango Delta and enjoy open vehicle game drives, walking safaris and boat & mokoro cruises with a professional guide. A scenic light aircraft flight takes you to Maun where this unforgettable safari ends.

Livingstone (Victoria Falls), Zambia



This unique, peanut-shaped country, once known as Northern Rhodesia, offers visitors an authentic African experience complete with adrenalin pumping adventure sports, a variety of fascinating cultural activities, and an abundance of indigenous wildlife, which finds refuge in Zambia's vast national parks. Spend your evenings enjoying the spectacular site of the world's largest waterfall, the Victoria Falls, while sipping on sundowners after an exhilarating day of whitewater rafting down the rapids of the mighty Zambezi River.



One of the original natural wonders of the world, the Victoria Falls is a World Heritage Site and an extremely popular tourist attraction. Known locally as 'The Smoke that Thunders' this spectacle is accessible from both Zambia and Zimbabwe and it is an ideal place to combine game viewing and water sports. There is excellent fishing, a terrifying bungee jump and arguably the best commercial whitewater rafting in the world.

Day Itinerary

You will be met by a Fly in Safari Company representative at the Livingstone International Airport and transferred to your hotel. Check in and have time to settle in and relax. Later in the afternoon you will be picked up in the reception area of the hotel for a transfer to the jetty where you will board a sunset cruise on the Zambezi. Return to the hotel after sunset and have the evening free to relax.

Day 3

Chobe River Front, Botswana



Situated in the southern reaches of Africa, Botswana is renowned for its pristine wilderness areas characterised by deep lagoons, wetlands, lush palms, rugged hills and desert plains scattered with scrubland. The country's primary tourist drawcard is undoubtedly the vast red expanse of the Kalahari Desert and its remarkably beautiful Okavango Delta, the largest inland delta in the world.

These natural wonders provide a tranquil haven for an abundance of African wildlife to thrive. Other highlights include the impressive Makgadikgadi Salt Pans, where visitors are privy to massive zebra migrations during the flood season; the Savuti plains, which host large prides of lions; and the Tsodilo Hills, where 4500 rock paintings form a unique record of human settlement over many millennia.



The Chobe River forms the northern boundary of the Chobe National Park, renowned for its diverse and abundant game viewing opportunities. This section of the park is best known for its dense concentration of wildlife including elephant and hippo populations, but the waters attract all manner of game including large herds of buffalo and the lions that prey on them. Visitors can look forward to some exciting activities such as: driving along the game-dotted river banks in a 4WD; cruising along the river in a motorboat, spotting rare birdlife and for a unique, luxury safari experience, hire a houseboat.

Day Itinerary

After breakfast you will be transferred to a safari lodge near the Chobe National Park, Botswana. Transfer time to Chobe is approximately 2 hours including border procedures and crossing the Zambezi River into Botswana. Your driver will assist with border procedures. Upon arrival at the lodge you will have time to settle in and relax before you depart on a sunset game viewing river cruise on the Chobe in the afternoon. Enjoy sun-downers while watching a beautiful African sunset before returning to the lodge after sunset.

Overnight: Chobe Bush Lodge

Chobe Bush Lodge is a brand-new property in Kasane right on the doorstep of the famous Chobe National Park, overlooking the African bush and located within 150m of the Chobe riverfront. This is where four diverse African countries converge, Botswana, Namibia, Zimbabwe and Zambia, which makes the town of Kasane an excellent

gateway to Chobe, Victoria Falls or the Caprivi. The lodge consists of 38 spacious luxury en-suite rooms, featuring an open plan bathroom with bath and shower, air-conditioning, TV and safe and tastefully furnished in modern-bush style design.

Families can be accommodated in one of 4 large exclusive family rooms which consist of two separate bedrooms, each with its own en-suite facilities. Rooms on the ground floor offer verandas as the perfect place of relaxation - top rooms are provided with balconies and have exquisite views over the Chobe National Park.

The Chobe also offers some of Africa's best bird watching. After an exciting game drive return to the lodge and have time to relax. In the late afternoon you will enjoy another game viewing activity; game drive or boat cruise. Return to the lodge after sunset and enjoy an evening of leisure.



Day 5

Okavango Delta, Botswana



Situated in the north-western corner of Botswana, the Okavango Delta is a World Heritage Site as it is the largest inland delta in the world. The magnificent Okavango River sprawls out over the dry sands of the Kalahari Desert forming this flourishing waterlogged oasis featuring countless meandering waterways and crystal-clear lagoons studded with water lilies, as well as fertile floodplains and reeded islands inhabited with abundant wildlife.

The Okavango Delta stretches over 15000 square kilometres. Visitors can look forward to enjoying activities such as game viewing, fishing, bird watching or taking an authentic guided Mokoro excursion through this wetland paradise in a traditional dugout canoe. Commonly spotted animals include: lion, rhino, leopard, giraffe, hippos, elephants, crocodiles and countless species of bird.

Day Itinerary

After breakfast you will get transferred to the Kasane Airport. A very scenic light aircraft flight will take you from Chobe to a landing strip in the Okavango Delta. You will get transferred to a luxury tented camp located in a remote area of the Okavango. Later in the afternoon you will enjoy a guided activity (approximately 3 hours). Activities are all included and vary between open vehicle game drives, mokoro cruises, boat cruises and island walking safaris. Enjoy sundowners at a scenic location. Return to camp after sunset and have the evening free to relax.

Overnight: Pom Pom Camp

In the heart of the Okavango Delta within the Matsebe concession area, Pom Pom Camp is another jewel in Botswana's crown! Pom Pom Camp is short 20-25minutes scenic flight over Okavango Delta from Maun. The camp overlooks a scenic lagoon and is quietly nestled under grove shady trees.

The camp has 9 large luxury safari tents, all with en suite showers and flush toilets; the bathrooms are enclosed for privacy, security and importantly offer you a truly unique bush adventure. In the main thatched building you will find a cozy bar, lounge and table settings for imaginative meals prepared by our safari chefs. This is a camp for the safari traditionalist!

Okavango Delta, Botswana

Day Itinerary

An early wakeup call to make the most of the morning for prime game viewing. Have a quick coffee or tea before you depart on a game drive for approximately 3 hours. We enjoy an exhilarating game drive tracking wildlife in the beautiful surroundings of the Moremi Game Reserve, a protected area notorious for frequent sightings of lion, leopard and cheetah. Sightings of the African Wild Dog are also frequently reported, an endangered species whose numbers are rapidly decreasing in other regions of Southern Africa.

After an exciting game drive, we return to the camp and have some time to relax and freshen up before a buffet lunch is served. In the late afternoon we go on a guided game viewing activity (game drive, boat cruise, mokoro cruise or walking safari for approximately 3 hours) and return to camp around sunset. Have some time to freshen up before pre-dinner drinks and snacks are served, followed by a hearty dinner.

Terms and Conditions

1. Pricing

Until final payment is received, all pricing is subject to change without notice due to supplier increases or currency fluctuations. The Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd will not be held liable for any price increases due to currency fluctuations. The prices listed are based on the costs and exchange rates current at the time of pricing. All rates are subject to change due to circumstances outside the control of the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd.

2. Deposit Payment

A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the full amount is required at the time of booking, with the balance to be paid not later than 60 days prior to departure of the tour. The following exceptions will apply: 1. Should any of the supplier's conditions vary from the above terms and conditions. 2. Should bookings be made less than 60 days prior to arrival full payment is required immediately.

3. Cancellation by traveller

The date of cancellation shall be the date on which the written notification is received by the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd After full payment, cancellation fees on trips will be a minimum of 50% per person of the value of the trip, plus any supplier fees on the land portion of your booking. Some airline tickets are non-refundable and in cases like this cancellation fees can be up to 100% of the value of the booking.

Please note: no-shows will be treated as cancellations and the necessary cancellation fees applied.

4. Cancellation Fees:

If you cancel a tour with Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd after making a booking you will lose some or all of the money you have paid for the trip. A cancellation will only be effective when we receive written confirmation of the cancellation. If you cancel a tour:

- 60 days or more prior to departure, we will retain your deposit.
- Between 30 – 59 days prior to departure, we will retain the deposit or 50% of the tour cost, whichever is greatest.
- Less than 30 days prior to departure we will retain 100% paid by you in connection with the booking.
- Any of the supplier's specific conditions that vary from the above will apply.

5. Refunds

No refunds will be made after departure. Prior to final payment, the deposit will be non-refundable.

6. Amendments to bookings

The Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd will not be liable for any loss or damage that may be incurred by the alteration, suspension or curtailment of services. If you wish to change your booking in any way, the following fees will apply:

- a. Changes to any other arrangements made in conjunction with your tour booking like hotels, transfers, flights and activities. Amendments to any other arrangements made in conjunction with your tour reservation will incur R500 administration fee per booking per change. This fee is in addition to any charges levied by hotels, lodges and airlines.
- b. No amendments are permitted to your booking within 10 days of departure.

7. Passport, visa and other travel documents

It is the client's responsibility to ensure that all documents, passport and visas are valid. The Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd will not be held responsible if you are refused entry to a country because you lack the correct visa documentation. The client accepts full responsibility for obtaining all the relevant travel documents required. Should a client be refused entry to any country due to incorrect documentation, the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd will not be liable for any costs of such delays or repatriation cost for the client.

8. Health

It is the responsibility of the client to consult a health professional with respect to recommended and compulsory vaccinations and health pre-cautions. Anti-malaria precautions are recommended for all tours and clients are advised to bring insect repellent.

9. Baggage information

All tours utilizing light aircraft transfers allow a maximum limit of 20 kg baggage per person, soft bags only. The Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd may not be held responsible for any loss or damage to luggage during the tour programme. The acceptance of final documents, vouchers or tickets shall be deemed to be consent to the above conditions.

10. Airline responsibility clause

The carriers concerned are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time the passengers are not aboard the aircraft or conveyance. The passenger ticket shall constitute the sole contract between the airline and the passenger. All personal effects and baggage are always the client's responsibility and the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd will not accept liability for any loss or damage to baggage or personal effect.

11. Insurance and Liability

Travel insurance is compulsory for all Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd clients. Your travel insurance must provide cover against personal accident, medical expenses, emergency repatriation and personal liability. We also recommend it covers cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage and personal effects. We strongly recommend that you take out travel insurance at the time of booking.

(Pty) Ltd act as an tour operator in regard to travel, whether by plane, 4 x 4, car or motor, coach, and assume no liability for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay, war, insurrection, revolt or other civil uprising, other military action, strikes or any Act of God occurring in either the country of origin, destination or through passage, or for any reason whatsoever, or through the acts or default of any company or persons engaged in conveying the passengers or in carrying out arrangements of the tour. They cannot accept any responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delay or changes in air schedules or other causes. All such losses or expenses will be the responsibility of the member of the tour. The right is reserved to make minor adjustments to the itinerary and the right is reserved to cancel any tour prior to departure.

It is understood that the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd will use their best efforts to ensure that all adequate measures are taken to avoid such occurrences.

By participating in a Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd tour you hereby agree to accept any risks. As Lawful consideration to the agreement with the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd to participate in such trips and activities, you hereby agree that you will not make a claim against the Fly in Safari Co. (Pty) Ltd and its employees from all claim actions and demands that you may have for bodily injury, death or property damage arising from your participation in a tour. Acceptance of the Tour Contract will serve as the release of Liability and Assumption of Risk agreement. This agreement is binding on your heirs, legal representatives and assigns.
